# **National League**

The feedback provided was welcomed and was critical in our decision to drop the National League from the 2019 calendar

- 60% of feedback submitted "didn't enjoy" National League
- 80% didn't like the format with "incomplete teams" being cited as a common reason



What was embraced was the enjoyment of being part of a team

#### Tournament changes as a result of member feedback

- Trios and 4 person teams have been added to the calendar introducing a team element
- Scratch & handicap sections have been added to tournaments to encourage all bowlers to participate
- Finals formats have been added to add more excitement to each event



# Background

- Few youth bowlers migrate from youths to adults. Thus, decreasing adult membership and overall competitiveness.
- High barrier to entry for youths to compete in adults

# **Tournament Changes**

## Youth (21 and under)

- Nationals (with Masters)
- Doubles
- Singles
- Fours
- Scottish Open
- Trios

## Adult (over 21)

- Nationals (with Masters)
- Doubles
- Singles
- AMF World Cup Qualifier
- Fours
- Scottish Open
- Trios
- Doubles



# **Tournament Changes**

- Aligning youth and adult tournaments
- Youths and adults would play the same tournament format in the same venue on the same lane condition



## **Youth Tournament Changes**

Squad – an allocated time to bowl for a division

Division – a separation of bowlers based on some criteria (e.g. age)

*Tournament* – a competitive environment made up of squads and divisions

- Youths will have two options for competing:
  - Pay a youth entry fee (plays in youth or adult squad)
  - Pay an adult entry fee (plays in an adult squad only)
- A youth paying a youth entry fee will be classed as a youth for that tournament
- A youth paying an adult entry fee will be classed as an adult for that tournament, but will receive ranking points for both youth and adults.



# **Squad Allocation Changes**

#### Youth

May play in adult OR youth squads

### Adult

Must play within adult squads

 Adult squads should occur before youth squads if there are multiple rounds in the tournament format. This allows youths bowling in adult squads to progress in their youth division.



# **Tournament Cost Changes**

## Youth

Increase from £30 to £35\*

## Adult

Dependent on tournament

\*Nationals will have increased cost to £40 to cover increase from 6 to 9 games and masters

# What benefits do I gain?

#### Youth

- Reduced barrier to entry into adult tournaments
- Gain ranking points for both youth and adults divisions
- Opportunity to compete and learn from the best bowlers in the country

#### Adult

- More participation in tournaments, resulting in an increased atmosphere
- Opportunity to encourage and influence the next generation of bowlers

#### **Overall**

- Increased number of bowlers transitioning from youth to adults
- Reduced bowler attrition



# Ranking System Changes



# **Points System**

- Points will be awarded on pin-fall in a sliding scale, in every trial/tournament
- The highest male pin-fall and female pin-fall, in their respective division gaining:
  - 1st 100
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> 95
  - 3rd 90
  - 4<sup>th</sup> 85
  - 5<sup>th</sup> 84 and so on in increments of 1 point from 4<sup>th</sup> place.



## **Ranking System**

Youth

## Old

- Youth rankings are points based on average per division on qualification rounds only
- Rankings are produced at the end of the season with a predefined start and end date (i.e. January December)

## New

- Youth rankings are points based on average per division on qualification rounds only
- Rankings will be continuous (i.e. will not have a defined start and end date)
- Best five from six most recent ranking events will always be used for team selection



## **Ranking System**

Adult

## Old

- Points based on tournament finishing position only
- Rankings are produced at the end of the season with a predefined start and end date (i.e. January - December)

## New

- Points based on tournament finishing position only
- Rankings will be continuous (i.e. will not have a defined start and end date)
- Best six from eight most recent ranking events will always be used for team selection



## **Ranking System**

Exceptions for 1st Year Implementation

- The new ranking system will apply from January 2019
- EYC team will be selected after the 5<sup>th</sup> ranking tournament in October, using best 4
  of 5 tournaments

No other national/international team selections are impacted

**Timelines for selecting teams for Youth Championships in 2020** 




- 2019 Confirmed ranking tournaments fall in these months

# **Rolling Ranking System**

Pros and Cons

Juniors and Adults

## Pros

- Teams are selected closer to each event so the team should be bowlers that are on 'form'
- Time set before each event to balance organisation, logistics, budget and training

## Cons

 New way of working for members, likely to take some time to embed

#### Seniors

- No Changes to ranking system from previous year
- Team will be selected from best 3 of 4 trial events on points based on average



## **Youth Selection Criteria**

# Youth Triple Crown (YTC)

- Best 5 from 6 most recent tournaments
- Top 4 boys and girls points from the respective age divisions (see Youth Triple Crown Changes)

# **European Youth Championship (EYC)**

- Best 5 from 6 most recent tournaments\*
- Top 4 boys and girls average from all 18 and under as at 1<sup>st</sup> Sep 2019

# World Youth Championship (WYC)

- Best 5 from 6 most recent tournaments
- Top 4 boys and girls average from 21 and under as at 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2020

YTC, EYC and WYC Team will be selected a minimum of 6 months prior to the event YTC – Feb, EYC – Oct, WYC – Nov

\* Best 4 from 5 most recent tournaments in 2019 because of the new rolling rankings



## **Adult Selection Criteria**

## ATC, EWC, EMC, WMC, WWC

- Best 6 from 8 most recent tournaments
- Top 6 men and/or women
- ATC Team will be selected 3 months prior to the event
- EWC, EMC, WMC, and
   WWC Team will be selected
   6 months prior to the event

#### **ECC**

Male and Female
 Masters winners

#### **AMF WC**

Male and Female AMF
 WC Qualifier winners



## **Senior Selection Criteria**

## **Senior Triple Crown (STC)**

- Best 3 of 4 trials
- Top 6 men and women on points

## **European Senior Championship (ESC)**

- Best 3 of 4 trials
- Top 4/6\* men and women on points

\* Inaugural event so unknown tournament format



## National/International Team Deposits

- All divisions (youth, adult, and senior) will be required to pay a non-refundable minimum deposit to accept their team place.
- A deadline for the deposit will be given in the offer.
- If the deposit has not been met before the deadline then the next available bowler that meets the criteria will be offered a position
- The deposit will be used to secure logistics, and administration fees

## Adult/Senior:

European Event - £250

World Event - £250

Triple Crown - £50



# **Upcoming Changes for 2020 Selection**

 In 2020, we plan to revisit average criteria for all national/international team selections, for 2021 teams





# Membership

- Membership cost will be increased as of 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019
- Membership fees will contribute towards:
  - Increasing ETBF Membership fees
  - Increasing ETBF and World Bowling Championship Entry Fees
  - Membership benefits (e.g. Online Membership Portal, New Website, National Team Shirt, etc.)



## **National Shirts**

- VIS Technical SportWear will be the official STB national shirt supplier (2 year deal)
- National/International athletes will be supplied with 1 shirt
- All national/international athletes will be expected to wear the national shirt ONLY
  during international duty

STB Members will be entitled to a 10% discount off all merchandise sold by **VIS**

# **Youth Triple Crown changes**

- The Presidium (committee from member countries) have proposed that the Youth Triple Crown format should change in 2020
- Changes include:
  - Removal of U21 division
  - Age bracket changes to U15, U18
  - Move back to teams of 6 boys 6 girls
- Our proposal:
  - We have requested that we postpone any change to the format to 2021, leaving 2020 format the same as last year
  - Discuss an alternative tournament to start in 2020 to fill the gap of the decrease and removal of age brackets
